Why a Climate Action Plan?




What is a Climate Action Plan?

A roadmap of key strategies and actions that the City and community can take to manage climate change impacts and risks, reduce emissions, and keep our community strong.



Key Components of CAP





Greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory & targets

Focus areas (e.g., transportation, buildings & energy, community resilience & wellbeing) & actions Community engagement elements Implementation plan

Foster City's Action to Date

- What has the City done so far?
 - Levee Improvements Project
 - Solar panels and EV charging station at the library/community center
 - Installed low-flow faucets and lower-energy lights in all City facilities
 - Switched to all-renewable energy for City facilities
 - Transitioned to low water using landscapes in parks
 - Offered rebate and financing programs to the community for energy efficient activities
 - Created a permanent Citizens Sustainability Advisory Committee
- How does this fit into other Foster City efforts?

Citizens Sustainability Advisory Committee

- The Citizens Sustainability Advisory Committee (CSAC) advises the City Council on sustainability issues facing Foster City regarding Environmental, Economic, or Social sustainability and researches, reviews, and provides comments on proposed programs and initiatives
- Currently assisting with community engagement and outreach for the Climate Action Plan Update
- 10 seats: (5) Foster City Residents, (2) Foster City Youth Residents, (2) In-Town Business Members (one major employer member seat and one small employer member – currently vacant) and (1) non-profit member
- Councilmember Sam Hindi is the City Council Liaison






What should Foster City's role be in climate action?


Do our part: encourage community to take action, set realistic targets, and revisit regularly. Longer implementation timeline.

Advocate: while doing our part, advocate and partner with other jurisdictions for broader regional and national climate action.

Lead: employ a strategic mix of voluntary actions, incentives, and regulations to achieve science-based emissions reduction targets.

> Be a pacesetter: set the pace for peer municipalities by adopting bold targets, policies, regulations, and mandates.






Planning Process Overview




